## Background

- Climate Change goal in the Community Sustainability Plan is:

  to reduce local contributions to climate change while increasing adaptation to climate change conditions.
- Plan recommends that municipalities within the GPA become members of the Partners for Climate Protections (PCP) program to create a plan to reduce their GHG contributions.
- City was already a member of PCP; County joined January 2014
- City Council, County Council, and the GPA EDC Board all approved the project
- Applied to the Federation of Canadian Municipalities Green Municipal Fund and the Ontario Trillium Foundation for funding

## Funding

FCM GMF approved a 2-year grant of \$175,000 on July 3, 2014

OTF approved a 3-year grant of \$225,000 on July 7, 2014

City confirmed a 10% cash contribution of \$44,500

Total approved project budget is \$444,500

### Request for Proposals

- The County of Peterborough issued Request for Proposal on behalf of the GPA EDC and the SP Coordinating Committee on July 23, 2014
- After 5 weeks, the RFP closed on Tuesday, August 26<sup>th</sup>
- 6 submissions were received
- Evaluation team consisting of Barb van Vierzen, Ken Doherty, Anca Pascalau, Melanie Kawalec and facilitated by Cathy Bazinet evaluated and short listed the proponents based on the evaluation matrix listed in the RFP on September 4<sup>th</sup>

- A Report recommending award of the RFP will be presented to the GPA EDC Board at their meeting on September 25<sup>th</sup>
- The preferred consultant will be advised immediately following the GPA EDC Board approval.

- GPA EDC is the lead applicant and the project oversight
- Climate Change Action Plan Steering Committee will oversee and administer the Scope of Work
- Melanie Kawalec will act as the Project Manager and primary contact for the Consultant and the CCAP SC
- Climate Change Working Group will work with the Consultant on Community Sector research, strategic development, and engagement
- Corporate Stakeholder Subcommittee will work with the Consultant on Corporate Sector research, strategic development, and engagement
