- Event netted approximately \$400 to be donated to Fleming College for bursary
- Major challenge in getting people out to event lots of effort required for relatively small number of people attending

## Work Plan Update

- Lengthy discussion around the value of events given the effort involved and limited time available by working group members
- Additional discussion around number of working group meetings held Melanie advised that other working groups meet much less frequently some just twice per year
- Group agreed to following:



- Reduce meeting frequency to quarterly but increase email communication/flow to keep momentum going
- Reduce focus on creating our own events and look to partner with other events being held by business groups/associations (i.e. Chamber of Commerce, Kawartha Manufacturer's Association)
- Increase focus on enhancing website including establishing a toolkit of resources and providing local success stories of business sustainability
- Look for opportunities to tap into other organization newsletters i.e. Peterborough Construction Association membership bulletin
- Look to establish a "Friends of SPBI" network to whom we can distribute a package of information, stories
  - Action: Cathy to send around draft of package
