HEALTHY ENVIRONMENT

21 Water Refill Stations installed across **9** municipalities/communities reaching **2000+** children each year

51 locations added to *bluewptbo.ca* which maps out locations to *fill your water bottle* for *FREE*

4500+ water bottles distributed to kids through programming, camp, school, child care centres and community events

18 child care centres received regular water promotion messaging, reaching

SKILLS

217 children and caregivers through **15** PRHC workshops learned how to make choosing water an easy part of their life

Flavoured Water Parties engaged **194** children at Ecology Park to learn about naturally flavouring their water

436 children learned how to *"Drink More Use Less"* in their classroom or community group with the Wonders of Water program

19 child care staff trained to offer *You're the Chef* food skills workshops in after-school programs



INVOLVE KIDS & CELEBRATE!

YMCA staff created fun *activities* and *newsletter* reminders to promote healthy hydration with campers and their parents

19 children were involved in shaping *"Nibi Giinwiindawan"*, an Indigenous water curriculum, which has been shared with local schools and First Nation communities

"Water Month" invited elementary students and the public to celebrate water, with **17** schools and **70+** parents taking part in the contests
